CHRISTIAN HELP REACHES \$100,000 MATCHING GIFT CHALLENGE

Christian HELP Employment and Resource Center has met its matching gift challenge from an anonymous donor, having raised \$100,000.

The \$100,000 will be dedicated to the Care Management Program, to the purchase of a replacement truck for food distribution for the hungry, and to the care and counsel of over 5,000 clients in the next year.

The \$100,000 gift challenge is the largest one received for the Spring Match Campaign since the start of Christian HELP in 1992.

“This match is significant because it enables us to provide assistance to thousands and helps to ensure the quality of our programs and services continue.” says Vickie Martin, Executive Director of Christian HELP. “It has also incentivized and inspired the community to fund the solutions for employment and hunger that Christian HELP provides for people in their own neighborhoods.”

In 2017, Christian HELP connected over 7,500 job seekers with employment and provided an additional 5,972 people with care, counsel and job leads. In addition, over 896,481lbs. of food was distributed to job seekers, all in an effort to empower family independence.
